Advanced Placement and International Baccalaureate Programs are extremely rigorous and are recommended for students who have demonstrated an interest in enrolling in high-level courses and are committed to hard work. Since AP/IB courses are designed to prepare students for college-level, subject-specific AP/IB exams, and possible college credits, the materials covered are extensive and the pace is rapid. If a student struggles with AP/IB courses, it is expected that he/she will commit to a greater effort and seek regular support services, one of which could be tutoring. Students wishing to enroll in AP/IB courses must make an appointment with a counselor. Students who are enrolled in the full IB program will have a set curriculum.

These courses directly affect college admission eligibility and merit-based financial aid. Students wishing to drop an AP/IB course at semester must meet with their counselor in order to submit an exit form prior to Thanksgiving break.

Students will not be enrolled in AP/IB Courses without a signed agreement by the student <u>and</u> parent or guardian. Students and parents must return the signed agreement no later than the second week of school.
